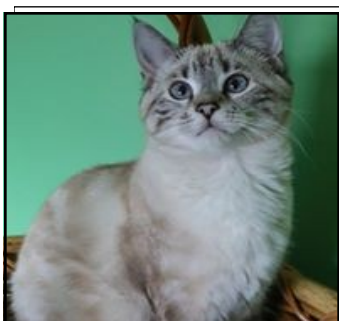

HAHS believes in educating the public on the benefits of spaying/neutering and offers assistance by facilitating low-cost spay/neuter clinics throughout the year.

Darlene and Jay Gilcreast have led full and interesting lives. Darlene and Jay have dedicated their lives to country, educating others, helping people and rescuing animals. Both served in the U.S. Military, Darlene as an Army Registered Nurse, Jay in the Navy during the Vietnam War. Both were also educators, her teaching nursing and he elementary school. It was somewhere during all this busyness that Darlene and Jay met, fell in love, married and raised a family.

For the past 7 years they have been active volunteers with HAHS. Darlene holds a board position as secretary and Jay is treasurer and membership chair. They are very instrumental in the TNR program (trap/neuter or spay/release) where feral cats are trapped, altered and released back into their outdoor environment. They have logged countless miles transporting animals to veterinary appointments and placing and maintaining winter housing for outside stray and feral cats.

Jay and Darlene live in Wabasha, Minnesota. Their household now includes 4 cats which are rehabilitated ferals they rescued. Despite volunteering countless hours to HAHS, they do manage to travel and escape the worst of Minnesota's winters by heading south.
