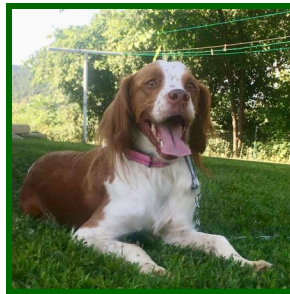


# SEASONS GREETINGS TO ALL FROM HIAWATHA ANIMAL HUMANE SOCIETY

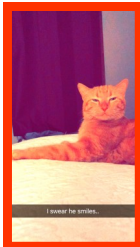

*3 years ago we found a kitten on petfinder.com. We called you and met him and his foster caregiver. It was awesome! "Felix" now goes by "Chester".*

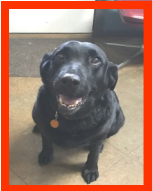
